

Chinuwa lives in Kibwa village, Kenekene Sub-county. He is an old man in his early seventies. He studied up to the level of senior four and later joined the forces. He served in the Police forces for a period of 36 years. He retired in 2005 when he was sixty two years old. He now runs a small business at his home town called Kobe Trading centre.

Last July, Chinuwa travelled to Kampala so as to buy some goods for his shop. He left Kobe Town around nine o'clock. The journey to Kampala took seven and a half hours. Chinuwa got tired as a result of the long journey. He slept during the long course of the journey. He did not ease himself as they travelled. When he got out of the bus, he left as if his bladder was bursting with urine. He could not make it to the public toilets, so he eased himself on one of the bus tyres.

No sooner did Chinuwa finish to urinate than the law-enforcement officers at the Qualicel Bus Terminal caught him. They threatened to take him to the Bus Terminal Police Post. One of them said, "You will be charged with littering the park with urine. You will be fined two hundred thousand shillings."

Chinuwa pleaded with the Officers but they could not listen. He told them that due to his body complications he could not have got to the public toilets easily. He begged that they <u>pardon</u> him and promised never to do it again. One of the men tried to grab his identity so that they may finally arrest him.
